What We Do

We are a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and registered charity in Washington State. Our dedicated group of volunteers and staff provide quality nature-based early childhood education in our all-outdoor classroom at Bowman Bay in scenic Deception Pass State Park. Our emergent curriculum is designed to promote creative thinking and problem solving, instill self-confidence and curiosity, and ensure a life-long sense of belonging in the outdoors!

Outdoor Time: Extended

In 2021-2022, we provided 10,500 hours of quality time outdoors for our preschoolers! This included 1,400 hours FREE for 8 families, thanks to generous donations and grant funding!

We received our permanent license as an Outdoor Nature-Based Childcare Provider, expanded our board, and hired an executive director to support our future growth.

Our board and volunteers donated over 1000 hours of their personal time in support of our school. Finally, our program continues to be immeasurably enhanced by continuing collaborations with State Park staff, Samish Indian Nation Education Program Manager Denise Crowe, and the Friends of the Anacortes Community Forest Lands.

Self Assessment


How well are we serving our families?

This year, detailed family surveys helped us assess our strengths and challenges.

We are proud to report that **89% of our** families agreed or strongly agreed that their child's and family's needs were well met at FNS, and that their family and child felt welcomed, valued, and included.

The most common challenges for families this year were getting ready in the morning (33%), lack of full-day classes (17%), packing food (17%), and transportation (17%).

Are we serving our whole community?
